

Enrollment Terms

Registration

To register, either 1) apply online using our online forms, you must print and mail the health form separately. If applying online or by fax you must mail your registration fee, postmarked within 48 hours of your submission 2) receive registration packet in mail fill out registration card and fax or mail with a registration fee of \$35.00. Applications will be processed in the order they come in. Final acceptance to the program is contingent on receipt and approval of all forms, including the medical form.

Deposit and Payment

To reserve your space in our adventure program payments to your camp sessions must be met. We have designed the following payment schedule to help with the minimum payment requirements. Payments over and above this schedule are welcome should you not choose to make payments on your camp fees. If you register after these dates have passed, you must pay atleast the percentage to bring you "current" along with the submission of your registration forms and \$35.00 registration fee.

Payments: 25% Paid by Feb. 15; 50% Paid by March 15; 75% Paid by April 15; 100% Final Payments Must be Received by May 15.

Confirmation of Receipt; Registration Forms

We will send you confirmation upon receipt of the application by e-mail or postal mail which ever is submitted. You can immediately download and print out our registration packet to be sent in by mail. All forms must be received no later than May 15th, including the medical form which must be completed by both you and your physician & signed by a physician. For all national and foreign national applicants immunization records must be current. A \$25 administrative fee will be assessed if all forms are not received by due date or within 2 weeks of registration if you registered late.

Safety / Assumption of Risk/ Itineraries

In all outdoor adventure programming involving travel in remote areas and the unpredictable forces of nature, there will be some element of risk. Please be assured that safety is our primary concern. We have high standards for staff qualifications, training, and safety policies and procedures. We provide the supervision, instruction, and equipment needed to minimize risk while participating in program activities. Under no circumstances shall Misty Hollow, its directors, other members, its lease holders and owners individually or corporately, councilors, other campers, other contractors for services we may use, be held liable for any damages whatsoever in the event of injury, illness, or death by any cause whatsoever including negligence of any involved. Please note that we contract out for services in some of our Specialized Trips such as White Water Rafting. Itineraries will be adhered to best as possible. Adverse weather and other unforeseen circumstances may necessitate changes in the schedule. If an activity is cancelled, every attempt will be made to reschedule or replace it with a similar one.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Our cancellation policy is based on our investment in food and equipment purchases, program planning, and staff training. Due to our small group size cancellation on short notice may often prevent others from attending and we may be unable to recover our expenses. Travel insurance is recommended to reimburse you for cancellation under certain circumstances. Refunds will be issued according to the following schedule.

Prior to April 1..... Full refund, less registration fee
Between April 1 and May 1.....Refund 75% tuition No Refund After May 1

If a cancellation after May 1 due to an illness or injury (documented by a physician), we will be happy to transfer tuition to another available camp session in the future (less any amounts already committed to an outfitter for a contracted activity). No refund will be given if a participant is sent home for behavioral issues or otherwise violating our Rules and Regulations Contract. Certain trips require a minimum number of participants. In the rare event that we must cancel a session prior to the starting date, we will refund all amounts paid.

Medical Treatment

We shall have the right to give first aid to any participant. We shall also have the right to retain the services of a physician, or if necessary, to hospitalize a participant. All expenses related to physician care, medication, or hospitalization (including travel expense if the participant has to be sent home) shall be paid by

the parent/guardian or reimbursed to us (such amounts will be added to the participant's camp store bill). We recommend all participants be covered by medical insurance. You may purchase an inexpensive policy specifically for the length of stay with us.

Equipment Destruction or Loss

The parent/guardian will be responsible for the misuse, willful destruction, or loss by the participant of any equipment. The cost of such items will be added to the participant's Base Camp Store bill. Any mistreatment of any of our animals at Misty Hollow Base Camp will result in camper being sent home and any vet bills incurred from a direct result of such mistreatment shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Model Release

The parent/guardian and the participant agree to the use by Misty Hollow of photographs, pictures, name, or likeness of the participant, and quotes from letters we receive from the participant or parent/guardian, for promotional purposes.

Family Camp Night

Family Camp Night is for enrolled campers and their families. Families may bring their own tent or use one of ours while supplies last. We will have some fun activities set up for your families to do together as well as a bonfire, dinner, and some fun awards. Campers must camp under the supervision of their parents or guardians. Registration, food, and fun are provided with a \$15.00 per adult/youth & \$5.00 for 12 & under age 3 & under free. Dates will be June 27 and Aug 8. Families must register at least 1 week prior to date attending.
